First Day :Day 1- Wadi el Hitan tour from Cairo

At 07:00 Am pick up from your hotel in Giza by Mini van and drive to Tunis village in Fayoum. It takes 2 hours drive, Once you arrive in Fayoum, You will take Jeep 4x4 to start your amazing adventure Wadi Al Hitan ' is a Protected area and a Natural Heritage Site added in 2005 by UNESCO as a world heritage site, WADI EL-HITAN is also known for scientists in the Zeuglodon Valley, have been discovered in 1936, it is located 35 KM west of the Wadi El-Ryan, right deep into the desert western desert, is It is an area of fossils; considered as an open museum, dates back to 45 million years and contains petrified primitive whales skeletons, shark teeth, shells and roots of Mangroves preserved in soft rocks. Everywhere you go here you find petrified seashells and corals.

Visit the Fossil & Climate Change Museum :

The museum hosts a variety of whale fossils, and skeletons that are displayed outdoors, as for the museum it has a variety of fossils, skeletons, fossilized mangroves, and ancient seashells exhibited indoors in glass boxes

Drive to The Magic lake and Gebel Al-Mudawara

The Magic lake:

One of the most beautiful lakes in Egypt, overlooking sand dunes, is the Magic lake. Around the lake gives you the chance to witness one of the most eye-catching sunsets you will ever see.

Magic Lake is a beautiful lake located in Wadi El Rayan in Fayoum. It was named the Magic lake as it changes its colors several times a day depending on the time of year and the amount of sunlight it receives.

It is an amazingly beautiful place surrounded by desert. People spend their time hiking & sand-boarding beside Magic Lake or even swimming in the lake itself.

The lake contains minerals that are said to help treat patients with rheumatism.

It's simply a magical place for a magical trip.

Gebel Al Mudawara:

Seven Kilometres south of the waterfall, Along the left eastern side of the road, Is a picturesque Area known as Al Mudawara, The Lookout, There are three Mountain along the lakeshore, it is a favorite Picnic Area



Wadi El Rayan:

Wadi El Rayan is a depression 42 Meters below sea level and covers 673 K.m. In 1966 this depression became a water reservoir when it was connected with Qarun Lake by underground Pipe Overnight in Camp near the magic Lake.

Second Day :Day 2 -Bahariya oasis Discovery tour:

You will be picked up from your camp in Fayoum and drive to Bahariya oasis ,it takes 5 hours drive ,Once you arrive, ,you will discover Bahariya Oasis ,we will visit the tombs of Bannentiu and Djed-Ankh-Amun-luf (Zed-Amun) The tombs at Qasr Selim (26th Dynasty) In 1938 the Egyptian archaeologist Ahmed Fakhry (1905-1973) discovered four tombs at the ridge of Qarat Qasr Selim. Visit Bawiti , Bawiti is the Capital of Bahariya Oasis ,Then Visit the Museum of the golden mummies and the temple of Ain El Muftella, Bahariya Oasis ,

Lunch will be served in Bahariya oasis. then you will make amazing trip to discover the oasis of Bahariya

The palm and olives fields, Gebel Maghrafa. where the biggest Diansour((Stromer's Tidal Giant) ever discovered in 1914 at the base of Gebel Dist. Lake al-Marun which is the biggest salt lake in Bahariya Oasis , Enjoy the sunset from The summit of the English Mountain(Gebel Al Ingleez). the view from the top offers a panorama of the northern part of the oasis .drive to ecolodge hotel in Bahariya for Check-in.



Third Day :Day 3 -the white desert:

At 06:00 am Pick up time from your hotel in Bahariya by Our Jeep 4x4. Drive to the black desert This name stems from the fact that there is a layer of black powder covering its mountains, highlands, and sand. This powder covers the summits of some mountains The black desert

12:00 The Lunch will be served here in El Haize oasis which is located 37 k.m from Bawiti ,Some people refer to this oasis as a separate oasis, during the roman time area was very Prosperous, and many of the current families were originally from Libya., Before lunch, you can immerse yourself in a hot water spring which will almost instantly reduce stress. The heat naturally



coaxes tense muscles to loosen up which in turn promotes feelings of calm, well-being, and tranquility.

Hotsprin in El Haz:

There is a museum here called the (water museum) which is built to show the people the importance of the underground water for the people of the desert and the instruments which were used by the Egyptians to raise the water for irrigation

13:00 Then drive to the valley of Agabat

14:00 Arrive at the Valley of Agabat is deep within the white desert white-desert Egypt 360 . You have to be there to feel the out-worldly beauty of the place. Millions of years ago, the place used to be under the sea. Over the years, unique rock formations of limestone, chalk (and maybe sand) developed. Then you will adventure the desert by discovering the Wadi el Agabat by Jeep 4x4 and Enjoy sandboarding -

Then drive to the Crystal Mountain .Crystal Mountain, locally known as Gebel al-Izzaz. It's more of a crystal hill, seen on the right, which is often called the Jewel of the desert is formed by the quartzite crystals and looks amazing in the sun's rays. A few decades ago, that natural feature has been found by accident.

16: 30 explore the white desert white-desert Egypt 360 National Park, the most well-known desert destination in Egypt.

17:30 Make tents and Enjoy the sunset

18:30 As the sky turns pink then the deepest fiery orange, the rock-shapes fade, and silence is all around. Sitting around a small fire and enjoying the simplest meal of chicken, rice, and vegetables, you will feel like nothing has ever tasted so good. Bedouin staff will arrange dinner and desert camping. (Vegetarian food is available)

Note: at night temperatures can drop suddenly in the White Desert a proper jacket would be necessary to spend the night comfortably- But don't worry we provide all camping equipment like sleeping bags, tents and mattresses

4Th Day :Day 4- White desert to Farafara:

At 06:00 am Enjoy sunrise Pick up from the white desert then drive to Farafra oasis to Visit Badr`s museum and Al Qasr in Farafra

Badr`s Museum:

Badr is a local artist and entrepreneur. He has an interesting museum which located in the village of Qasr, It has been abandoned for wonderful mudbricks structure that the artist built himself, inside is every thing from taxidermy to sculpture, and Paintings, are on display

Farafra Fortress(Qasr):

The Fortress of Farafra dominates the top of the hills. Like its counterparts. in other oases. It was once a walled city used by the inhabitants as a protection from the invaders. The villagers would hasten to the fortress for safety

Bir Sitta:

Bir Saba (Well 7), hot springs in the desert where you can soak in the evening or at nighttime while gazing up at the stars

Drive to Dakha which is 300 K.m from Farafra

5th Day :Day 5: Dakhla

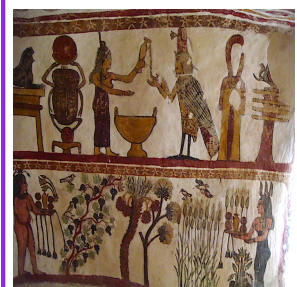
Pick up from your hotel in Dakhla to visit Dakhla`s oasis attractions

AL-DAKHLA OASIS:

The green oasis with sprawling agricultural lands

Necropolis of al-Muzawwaqa:

Located 37 km north of the village of Mut, which includes hundreds of Roman tombs, including two very well-preserved painted ones.. al-Muzawwaqa in Arabic means Decorated, Dr Fakhry dates the tombs to the first and second centuries. Two Tombs stand out: The single room tomb of Petubastis and the Double room tomb of Padiosiris both are decorated with exquisite Full-color paintings which defy the ancient conventions of the tomb decoration.



Qila al-Dabba Necropolis and Ain Asil:

In the village of Balat, the former Old Kingdom capital of Al-Dakhla and the oldest excavated village of Ancient Egypt. It contains the well-preserved remains of a settlement and a monumental necropolis of the 6th Dynasty.

Deir al-Hagar Temple:

Deir al-Hagar Temple, in Arabic the monastery of stones, alone roman temple located south of the cultivated area in the desert, is made of sandstone. erected during the reign of Nero (54-67) and during the time of vespasian (69.79) Titus (79-81) and domitian, the temple was built in honor of the thebian triad (Amun, Mut and Khonsu) but is also dedicated to Seth, the god of the oasis, the latter god is represented with falcon head, the cartouches of the roman emperors appear on the temples..

6th Day : Day 6 - Kharga to Luxor:

Pick up from Your Hotel in Dakhala then drive to Kharga to Visit Kharga oasis attractions

Hibis Temple:

The largest and better-preserved temple in Al-Kharga, built over hundreds of years during successive Dynastic, Persian, Ptolemaic, and Roman periods.

Al-Gheweta Temple:

Built on top of remains of a pharaonic settlement during the Persian occupation in Al-Kharga.

Temple of Kasr al-Zayan:

Built by the Greeks and dedicated to the town god Amun-Hibis.

Necropolis of al-Bagawat:

One of the oldest Christian burial grounds in the world, combining pharaonic and Christian burial practices.

Old Baris:

In antiquity Baris was an important trading center along Darab- Al-



Arbain-They carried a healthy trade directly with the Nile valley at Esna, They export dates, Rice and Fruit, brought back wheat, which was sold to the caravans along the Darab Al Arbain.. Located 86 K.m south of Qasr Kharga . Local inhabitants still consider it as separate oasis. Darfur Caravan rested here a few days to trade and camels before going south . In 1893

The temple of Dush:

while the main route of the Darb Albain goes South from Baris to Maki and Qasr, another goes southeast to Dush, then east to the Nile valley
