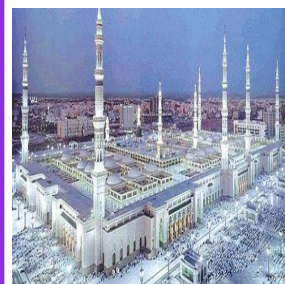
First Day :Day 1: Arrival in Madinah

Guided Visit to Historical Sites:

Quba Mosque: The first mosque built in Islam.

Mount Uhud: Site of the famous Battle of Uhud.

Masjid al-Qiblatain: The mosque where the Qibla was changed.

Jannat al-Baqi: Visit the historic cemetery where many of the Prophet's family and companions are buried.

Personal Time for Reflection and Prayers: Spend the evening at Al-Masjid an-Nabawi.

Third Day :Day 3: Journey to Makkah & Umrah Rituals

Morning Departure to Makkah: Travel by HHSR. (Haramain

Train) (approx. 2 : 20 hours).

Miqat (Ihram): Stop at the Miqat (Bir Ali) to enter the state of Ihram, declaring the intention to perform Umrah.

Arrival in Makkah & Hotel Check-in: Arrive in Makkah and check into your hotel near Masjid al-Haram.

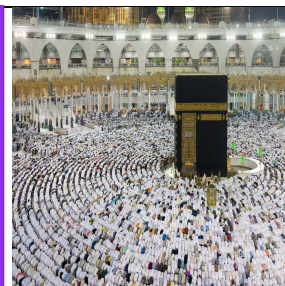
Perform Umrah Rituals:

Tawaf: Circulate the Kaaba seven times.

Sa'i: Walk between the hills of Safa and Marwah seven times.

Halq/Taqsir: Shaving or cutting a portion of hair to conclude Umrah.

4Th Day :Day 4: Prayers and Personal Worship in Makkah

Free Morning Fajr Prayers at Masjid al-Haram.

Zamzam Well: Drink from the blessed Zamzam water.

Free Day for Worship

Start your tour to discover Makkah sightseeings Includes:

Mount Arafat (Jabal Arafat)

Located about 20 kilometers east of Makkah, it is a key pilgrimage site, where pilgrims gather during the Hajj on the Day of Arafah. The mount is significant as the place where Prophet Muhammad delivered his Farewell Sermon.

Jabal al-Nour (Mountain of Light)

Famous for the Hira Cave, where Prophet Muhammad received his first revelation from the Angel Jibreel (Gabriel). Many pilgrims hike up the mountain to visit the cave, which holds deep spiritual significance.



Jannat al-Mu'alla Cemetery

A historic graveyard where many of Prophet Muhammad's relatives and companions are buried, including his first wife, Khadijah. It's a place of reflection for many visitors.

Abraj Al-Bait Clock Tower

A massive clock tower complex located near the Masjid al-Haram, part of a larger hotel complex. It has the world's largest clock face and offers an observation deck with panoramic views of Makkah.

The tower also houses the Makkah Royal Clock Tower Museum, which explores the history of time measurement and the Islamic lunar calendar.

Jabal Thawr

Another important mountain, known for the Cave of Thawr, where Prophet Muhammad and his companion Abu Bakr sought refuge while fleeing to Medina during the Hijra (migration).

. Mina and Muzdalifah

These areas are significant stops during the Hajj pilgrimage. Mina is known for the Jamarat, where pilgrims perform the symbolic stoning of the devil. Muzdalifah is where pilgrims collect pebbles to perform this ritual.

These locations, while largely centered on religious and spiritual experiences, offer a blend of historical, cultural, and scenic attractions for pilgrims and visitors to Makkah.

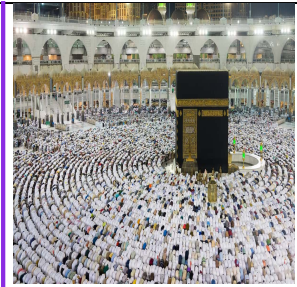

6th Day :Day 6: Free Day for Worship:

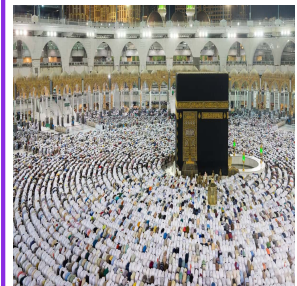
Fajr Prayers at Masjid al-Haram.
