First Day : Alexandria Day tours

A day tour to Alexandria from Cairo is a fantastic way to experience the beauty, history, and culture of Egypt's coastal city. The journey takes approximately 2.5 to 3 hours by car or train, and there's plenty to explore in just one day. Here's an itinerary for a day tour to Alexandria from Cairo:

Start your day early from Cairo (around 7:00 AM) to make the most of your time in Alexandria. You can either travel by private car , Arrive in Alexandria and begin with a visit to the Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa.

Catacombs, sometimes called the Hill of Treasure, is thought to be a massive royal cemetery and necropolis that was built in the second century AD. The murals on the walls and the designs of the tombs, statues, and burial items all showcase the necropolis' distinctive blend of Roman, Hellenistic, and Pharaonic art influences. One of the seven marvels of the Middle Ages was the archeological site.

Next, head to Pompey's Pillar, a massive red granite column standing 25 meters tall, which is one of Alexandria's iconic landmarks. Nearby, explore the Serapeum, the ruins of a temple dedicated to the god Serapis, which once housed a famous library. Take some time to walk around and soak in the history of this ancient site.

After that we will have a Lunch at a Seaside Restaurant , For lunch, head to one of Alexandria's well-known seafood restaurants along the Corniche (the seafront promenade). Enjoy a delicious seafood meal with Mediterranean views. Fishawi's, Abu Ashraf, and Balbaa are popular choices for fresh fish and local delicacies, such as grilled fish or seafood soup.

After lunch, visit the Bibliotheca Alexandrina, the modern reincarnation of the ancient Library of Alexandria. The architecture is stunning, and the library offers a fascinating collection of books, exhibitions, and a planetarium. Explore the



impressive structure and its surroundings, and take time to appreciate the cultural significance of this contemporary tribute to the ancient library.

Next, head to the Qaitbay Citadel, located on the site of the ancient Pharos Lighthouse, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. This 15th-century fortress offers panoramic views of the Mediterranean Sea and Alexandria's coastline. Explore the citadel's museum, learn about its history, and enjoy the incredible sea views.

After that head to The Roman Amphitheatre in Alexandria is an ancient structure built in the 2nd century AD during the Roman period. It is the only Roman amphitheatre in the city and could seat about 800 spectators. The amphitheatre is made of marble and has 13 rows of seats arranged in a semi-circle around a central performance area. It was used for various events like gladiator battles and theatrical performances. The site also features beautiful mosaic flooring and is known for its excellent acoustics. It's located in the Kom El-Dikka area and is a significant example of Roman architecture in Alexandria.
