First Day :Trip to Portsaid from Cairo

.Pick up from Your hotel in Cairo or Giza at 07:00 then drive to Portsaid -the journey takes about 3 hours.Our tour will begin at the Suez Canal Tourist Promenade, known as "De Lesseps Promenade" which directly overlooks the Suez Canal waterway. The promenade has two entrances: the northern entrance, known as the "De Lesseps Statue" which is the base where the statue of the mastermind behind the Suez Canal project once stood before its removal, and the southern entrance near "Misr Square" a plaza featuring the "Mother of the World" statue, symbolizing the history and efforts of Egyptians in digging the Suez Canal. Near the promenade, you can find the Old Port Said Lighthouse, built during the reign of Khedive Ismail in June 1869. This lighthouse is considered the first in the world to be constructed using reinforced concrete, and its construction was overseen by the famous French engineer François Coignet.

You can also enjoy a quick tour along Port Said's Corniche and Al Jomhuria Street, where you'll find many shops, restaurants, and cafés. Don't miss the chance to attend a "Simsimeya Music" performance, a traditional folk music genre unique to the people of Port Said and the Suez Canal region. Additionally, you can explore different places in the city by horse-drawn carriage (Hantour) for a delightful and unforgettable experience.

Port Said is also home to several museums, the most famous of which is the Military Museum, which was inaugurated in 1964 to commemorate the Tripartite Aggression against Port Said. It stands as a historical witness to the bravery of the city's people in defending their homeland..

Now, it's time for another unique experience in Port Said—one that feels like traveling to a different continent! By crossing the canal to the opposite bank, you'll find yourself in Port Fouad, the Asian side of Port Said Governorate.To reach the other side, you must take the ferry, an experience that is both charming in its simplicity and deeply rooted in the city's heritage. As you and your car are transported on a large boat, you can enjoy the stunning sea views and the sight of seagulls soaring above.

Upon arriving in Port Fouad, you'll immediately notice the



architectural differences compared to the other side of the canal. Many of the houses here are built with two or three floors, giving the city a unique charm. There are plenty of fascinating places to explore in Port Fouad. One highlight is the Port Fouad Nature Reserve, where you can see and even feed flamingos with bread before setting off on a quick boating trip in the delta near the ferry dock. Port Fouad is also home to a beautiful beach, one of the best and most famous in Port Said, known for its soft golden sands and crystal-clear waters. For a truly unique adventure, head to Salt Mountain, a paradise for photography enthusiasts! This site resembles the Arctic or snow-covered landscapes, offering an extraordinary setting that feels like a winter wonderland. It's the perfect place for you and your children to enjoy a magical experience and capture unforgettable memories.

The city also features several parks and gardens, the most famous of which is Ferial Garden, a historically significant landmark in Port Said. There's also El-Farma Garden, which boasts a French-style design, combining stone pathways with lush green areas filled with trees, making it one of the most distinctive leisure spots in Port Said. there is a dedicated area for purchasing musical instruments, as well as opportunities to enjoy various artistic performances that are occasionally organized there.

You simply can't visit Port Said without indulging in its famous fresh seafood! The city's seafood restaurants and fish markets are a trademark of Port Said, offering an unforgettable culinary experience.

You can head to the Fish Market, where you can buy fresh fish, have it cooked on the spot, and enjoy a delicious meal right there. Alternatively, you can visit one of the many seafood restaurants scattered throughout the city to savor a flavorful seafood experience unlike anywhere else.
